 - a. *Second Interim Budget Report, R#111-03-04. The Board is requested to approve the Second Interim Budget Report.
 - b. *Resolution#16-03-04 to Lay off Certificated Staff. The Board is requested to approve Resolution#16-03-04 to Lay off Certificated Staff.
 - *CSBA Delegate Assembly Election, R114-03-04. Annually, members of California governing boards elect members to the California School Board Association (CSBA)
