February 6, 2001 GOVERNING BOARD MEETING, DESCRIPTION OF ACTION ITEMS

1. <u>First Reading[Asterisk (*) denotes action may be taken on the first reading.]</u>

- a. *Rejection of Claim, R145-00-01. A claim has been filed against the La Cañada Unified School District. The district's Claims Administrator, Carl Warren and Company, has requested that the district send a rejection letter to the individual filing this claim.
- b. *Proposed Board Calendar for 2001-2002, R142-00-01. The Board is requested to approve the proposed calendar for Board meetings for 2001-2002.
- c. *Job Descriptions, R150-00-01. The Board is asked to approve the following job descriptions: Director I of Maintenance/Operations and Transportation, Director II of Facilities and Construction, Groundsperson.
- *Memorandum of Understanding between La Cañada Unified School District and California School Employees Association, R151-00-01. Effective January 1, 2001, employee bargaining associations have the right to collect an agency fee from all employees they represent. CSEA Chapter 122 has given the district notice to start payroll deductions on February 1, 2001. At the request of the District the Association has agreed to categorize Auditorium Technicians as "short term employees" and therefore not represented by CSEA. This means Auditorium Technicians will not have to pay agency fees. The Board is requested to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between La Cañada Unified School District and California School Employees Association.
- e. *Subsequent Variable Term Waiver, R159-00-01. La Cañada currently has employed a temporary teacher at Paradise Canyon Elementary who has not yet completed credential requirements. This waiver request is for a calendar year beginning March 2001. The Board is requested to approve the Variable Term Waiver Request.
- f. *Core Literature List Revision, R152-00-01. The department teachers based the revision, moving <u>The Glass</u> <u>Menagerie</u> from Grade 9 to Grade 8, on the need to teach symbolism and imagery in 8th grade. The Board is requested to approve the Core Literature List Revision.
- g. *Agreement with University of Southern California Department of Occupational Science and Occupational Therapy for Field Experience Work, R153-00-01. University of Southern California has an undergraduate program in Occupational Therapy; field experience is a required and integral component of the program. It has been requested that the district provide field experience for these students. The approval of the agreement at this time means that the district is contractually prepared to assist students from the USC Occupational Therapy program. The Board is requested to approve the agreement with the University of Southern California for Department of Occupational Science and Occupational Therapy.
- h. Potential New Courses at La Cañada High School for the 2001-2002 School Year, R157-00-01. The following new courses are being recommended by staff as a way to best service identified student need: Art Portfolio Preparation, Beginning Clay, Personal Management. These courses are being presented for first reading only.

- b. Board Policy 7141 Bid Process on Public Construction Projects, R136-00-01. With the passage of Assembly Bill 2182 during the 1999-2000 Legislative Term, effective January 1, 2001, newly enacted Public Contract Code section 20103.8 will revise the procedure which the District must follow for determining the lowest bidder on a public works project if additions or deletions from the base bid are considered. The Board is requested to approve Board Policy 7141 Bid Process on Public Construction Projects.
- c. Award Bid Division 22, La Cañada High School Library, R147-00-01. Bid proposals for Sheet Metal were accepted on December 19, 2000. Woodley Custom Metal was the low bid. The Board is requested to approve Woodley Custom Metal as Bid Division #22 contractor.
- d. Change Order for La Cañada High School Trans Therm, R149-00-01. The current contract for Bid Division #16 (plumbing) by Trans-Therm is \$80,888.71.
