PROPOSED ACTION ITEMS

- 1. <u>First Reading</u> [Asterisk (*) denotes action may be taken on the first reading.]
 - a. *Site Safety Plans, R177-02-03. Pursuant to Education Code every school in California is required to develop a comprehensive school safety plan to address safety concerns identified through a systematic planning process. All plans were approved by the School Site Councils at meetings to which the mayor, LCTA rep, PTA rep, CSEA rep, and student government rep were invited. The Board is requested to approve the Site Safety Plans.
 - b. *Accept School Accountability Report Cards, R178-02-03
 - c. Grades K-2 Open Court Adoption: English Language Arts, R183-02-03. Representatives from each grade level came together as a district committee to discuss recommendations. Based on specific criteria established by the district, **Open Court** was selected for grades K-2. This item if presented for first reading
 - d. Grades 3, 4, 5 Houghton-Mifflin Adoption: English Language Arts, R184-02-03. Representatives from each grade level came together as a district committee to discuss recommendations. Based on specific criteria established by the district, Houghton Mifflin's <u>A Legacy of Literacy</u> was chosen for grades 3-5. This item is presented for first reading.
 - e. Grades 6-8 Textbook Adoption: English Language Arts, R185-02-03. Language arts teachers in grades 6-8 came together as a district committee to discuss recommendations. Based on specific criteria established by the district, Language of Literature was selected for grades 6-8. This item is presented for first reading.

2. Second Reading

- Resolution #27-02-03 Authorizing Issuance of 1999 General Obligation Bonds Series B. With the passage of the December 14, 1999 election, LCUSD was given the approval for the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds of the District in the maximum amount of \$6,000,000. On April 19, 2000, the district issues \$3,500,000 of 1999 General Obligation Bond, Series A. It is necessary to request the issuance of the second series of such bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$2,500,000. This resolution is required to begin the procedure for issuance of these bonds. The Board is requested to approve Resolution #27-02-03 Authorizing Issuance of 1999 General Obligation Bonds Series B
- b. Board Policies 5000 Series Students, R171-02-03. The District is currently in the process of updating LCUSD Board policies and aligning them with California School Boards Association (CSBA) recommendations where necessary. The Board is requested to approve Board Policies 5000 Series Students.
- c. Textbook Adoption Foreign Language, R175-02-03. The current Foreign Language textbooks are seriously outdated. The teachers of each foreign language reviewed several books and chose the ones most closely aligned with the national standards of the American Council for Teachers of Foreign Language. These recommendations are being presented for first reading.
