1. <u>First Reading</u> [Asterisk (*) denotes action may be taken on the first reading.]

- a. *First Interim Budget and Budget Revisions, R99-01-02. This is an update of the June budget with actual data as of October 31, as well as the most current projections.
- b. *Resolution #12-01-02 Authorized Signatures. Each year in December it is necessary for the Governing Board to authorize certain employees to sign for contracts, reports, leases, data processing, etc., which have been approved by the Governing Board. The Board is requested to approve Resolution #12-01-02 Authorized Signatures.
- c. *Resolution #13-01-02 Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred by Board Members. Each year it is necessary for the Governing Board to adopt a resolution regarding the reimbursement of expenses. The Board is requested to approve Resolution #13-01-02 Reimbursement of Expenses incurred by Board representatives.
- d. *Approve Board Meeting Calendar for 2002-03, R115-01-02. At the Annual Organizational Meeting of the Governing Board held in December of each year, the Board sets the Board Meeting calendar for the following school year.
