## September 11, 2001 GOVERNING BOARD MEETING, DESCRIPTION OF ACTION ITEMS

## 1. <u>First Reading[Asterisk (\*) denotes action may be taken on the first reading.]</u>

- a. \*Subject Matter Authorization, R38-01-02. According to Education Code 44258.3, an individual who holds a credential other than an emergency permit, may be assigned to teach any subjects in departmentalized classes in grades K-12, inclusive, provided the governing board verifies the teacher has adequate knowledge of each subject to be taught and the teacher consents to the assignment. The Board is requested to approve the Subject Matter Authorization for the teachers listed.
- b. \*Approval of Continuation of Pilot Skateboard Park, R41-01-02. On August 20, 2001, the Joint Use Committee conducted its evaluation of the Skate Park, and concluded that the summer pilot project was a success. The JUC recommended that the City Council and the School Board extend the pilot project period through January 31, 2002, with another evaluation in December. The Board is requested to authorize the extension of the pilot project Skate Park through January 31, 2002 and authorize the Superintendent to execute the Supplement Agreement #2.
- c. \*Action on Playground Safety Committee Recommendations, R-49-01-02. The Playground Safety Committee has presented 11 recommendations to the Board. The Board is requested to adopt the recommendations of the Playground Safety Committee.
- d. \*Approval of 2000-01 Unaudited Actuals, R42-01-02. Section 42100 of the Education Code requires that the Governing Board of each school district approve an annual statement of all receipts and expenditures of the District for the preceding fiscal year and file the statement with the County Superintendent of Schools on or before September 15. The Board is requested to approve the 2000-01 Unaudited Actual Financial Report, to authorize the Superintendent or designee to sign the 2000-01 District Certification of Unaudited Actual Financial Report, and to authorize the single adoption process for the 2001-2002 budget.
- e. \*Renewal of Agreement for Services for Mandated Cost Reimbursement Claims, R43-01-02. Each school district is constitutionally entitled to be reimbursed by the State for programs mandated but not funded. The Reynolds Consulting Group, Inc. has extensive experience in the preparation and filing of mandated cost claims. The Board is requested to approve the contract with the Reynolds Consulting Group to perform special projects, especially as they relate to the preparation and filing of mandated cost reimbursement applications.
- f. \*2001-02 Budget Calendar, R44-01-02. The attached 2001-2002 Budget Calendar reflects important timelines for preparation and approval of the District budget. The Board is requested to approve the 2001-2002 Budget Calendar.
